Staff/Student/Parent Relations**

The Board encourages parents to be involved in their student's school affairs and, unless otherwise ordered by the courts, an order of sole custody to one parent shall not deprive the other parent access to student's educational records, or to attend parent conferences and consult with school staff.

The parent having sole custody will be contacted before such records are released to a noncustodial parent. Only if the parent having sole custody presents a court document to the contrary will the noncustodial parent be denied access to the records. Otherwise, the noncustodial parent may receive and inspect school records and consult with school staff concerning the student's welfare and education to the same extent as provided the parent having sole custody.

Noncustodial parents or relatives of the noncustodial parent will not be granted visitation or telephone access to the student during the school day nor will a student be released to the noncustodial parent without written permission of the parent having sole custody. It is the custodial parent's responsibility to provide legal documentation about custody, visitations or restraining orders when controversy exists.
