Dear Sisters Schools Community,

In an effort to support Governor Brown’s guidelines, Sister school will be cancelling face to face conferences and communicating via phone and email and focus on students who need to continue to reach their growth targets.

Additionally, we have suspended out of state travel for school sponsored groups. We continue to be in almost hourly communication with local Public Health agencies, Oregon Health Authority, Oregon Department of Education and the Centers for Disease Control (CDC).

Key points of Governor Brown’s message:

All gatherings of more than 250 people in Oregon will be canceled for the next four weeks in an effort to slow the spread of coronavirus, Gov. Kate Brown announced Wednesday night.

Brown said public schools should remain open. But she said all non-essential school-associated gatherings and group activities — such as group parent meetings, field trips, and competitions -- should be cancelled.

Brown defined gathering is defined as any event in a space in which appropriate social distancing of a minimum of three feet cannot be maintained.
