You will enter the parking lot and drive around through the various stations, exit and enter the bus lane and drive through those stations. The stations will include:

- **Chromebook drop off-** drop off your Chromebook, cord and hot spot if you have one; you can also bring a check or cash for insurance payment
- **Work Packets-** pick up your June 8-12 and summer packets as well as any missed previous packets
- **Food drive donations-** please help our Leadership support our community- if each student brings one item we will have collected 350 items!!! That would go a long way in helping our community.

We will be doing this by grade levels. Please come within your scheduled time and see your teachers, and try to stagger your arrival to allow space between families.
