Dear Sisters Schools Community,

We were notified today that we have confirmed COVID-19 cases in the high school. We reached out to Deschutes County Health Department to discuss the situation. Initial contact tracing identified a connection to our middle school. As a result of this conversation, we need to move grades 5 through 12 to Distance Learning tomorrow. This will allow us the time to conduct more thorough Contact Tracing to truly identify who was impacted and to help us determine the next steps.

Additionally, at this time we need to cancel all school related activities for the middle and high school until tomorrow afternoon. Sisters Elementary School will have in-person school on Thursday.

If any student believes they have been in close contact, which is within six feet for a total of fifteen minutes within a 24-hour period, of a COVID-19 positive person, please contact your school.

Our team will be contacting many families to accurately assess the impact of this situation. We will send another communication out tomorrow afternoon with any updated information or needed actions.
