The high school will be back in-person for four days a week starting Monday, April 12th. The staff is prepared for students to be back in full session.

Joan shared that SES is able to start adding more students, in-person, to classrooms due to the change in social distancing requirements. Kindergarten Roundup will be held next Friday, April 16th. They anticipate a large kindergarten group for next year. The staff is reviewing how they can revise their “end-of-year” traditional activities so they will be COVID compliant. Pre-K enrollment is now 11

students. SES has hired new Special Education, 3rd grade, and STEAM teachers. They will also be hiring a new Music teacher.
